He teaches architectural design, urban design, architectural morphology, urban and architectural identity, and research methods. His research fields are culture and space interaction; housing design and assessment for disabled and aged; architectural and urban identity; architectural education; design studio; quality in design education. He acted as Head of the Department of Architecture at Istanbul Technical University (2000-2004), Dean of the Faculty of Architecture at Istanbul Technical University (2008-2012), Dean of the Faculty of Architecture and Design at Özyeğin University (2013-2020), Head of Mimarlık Akreditasyon Kurulu (Accreditation Board of Architecture – Turkey) (2008), Editor and editorial board member of “A/Z ITU Journal of the Faculty of Architecture” (2004-2012), publishing coordinator and editorial board member of “Arkitekt” (journal of architecture) (2007-2009), editorial board member of “Studio” (Journal for design studios of Istanbul Technical University Faculty of Architecture) (1998-2003). He currently works as the editorial board member of “Journal of Design Studio” starting from 2019 and head of Board of Directors of Association for Accreditation of Architectural Education (MiAK) starting from 2022.
